Using line-height with non-integer values, like 1.2em, inherits a problem

The line-height is 1.2em; div div {font-size: 200%;}

The quick brown fox

It has an additional problem with line-height

The 200% value adds separate div-divs, those for which line-height of the parent are specified in em or %, v
